Legal  
Issue

At the start of the meeting, Council discussed the issue of the letter from Aikins, MacAulay & Thorvaldson regarding the purchase of Dunn-Rite Farms property by J.P. F. Farms Ltd. Mr. Bruce Gregory has indicated that he is in a conflict with this situation and advised that Council seek other legal advice. It was recommended to Council to use the services of Bob Adkins and Maggie Wiebe of the firm of Thompson, Dorfman, Sweatman. The view of Council was not to engage the services of a lawyer at this time and to give a very limited response to Mr. Chappell's letter. Council did not want the expense of a solicitor until such time as those services are more necessary.

Regarding the Rosenort Dyke project, it was mentioned that the road West of Section 16-6-1 EPM is in poor shape relative to the damage done to the road in the construction of the dyke. Project

At approximately 11:15 a.m., Council met with Mr. Germaine Vermette concerning a proposal that the R. M. of Montcalm is pursuing relating to the Rosseau River and its flooding. Their Proposal is to construct a number of large bridge crossings on the PR 246 extension south of PR 217 to allow the flood water from the Rosseau River to flow into the Red River. Council's view was that they would not be supportive of this project.
