RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held a Special Meeting at 9:00 A.M. on Thursday, May 23rd, 1985 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Dan Thiessen presided.

Present were Councillors: George St. Hilaire, Larry Gluck, Glenn Curdt, W. F. Recksiedler, Donald Hamblin, David Waldner.

The purpose of this meeting is to establish policy and municipal action to be taken in the event of a serious grasshopper infestation.

Following a very lengthy discussion on the aspect of spraying for grasshoppers and what areas would be done and the responsibilities which the municipality would assume and those of the individual.

Grasshoppers Moved by Don Hamblin, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:

#95/85. Whereas there is projected to be an infestation of grasshoppers in this municipality;

Therefore Be It Resolved that the Rural Municipality of Morris enact the following policies for the control of the grasshoppers;

- 1. The major Municipal and Provincial drains shall be aerial sprayed as may be required.
- 2. The road allowances are to be sprayed by the local farmers, if they wish to do so, and that chemical shall be dispensed on the basis of 2 acres for one side of the road allowance per half
- 3. That each councillor is responsible to decide the needs for his ward.
- 4. That Railway lines and Provincial Roads having a wide ditch area are to be aerial sprayed where permission is granted to do so.

 Carried.

Following this, there was some dis**W**ssion relating to the use of the old tractor and mower and what is to be done with the machine. And also, the discussion included the possible replacement of our current 10 foot woods mower to a more practical mower.

The meeting was then adjourned at 12:00 o'clock noon.
