Municipal Bonspiel Note:

At this meeting, Council decided to again hold the municipal bonspiel for local people of the municipality. It was decided that the bonspiel would be held on March 20th, 1986 at the Morris Curling Rink and that the charge would be \$28.00 per rink or \$7.00 per person curling. For format of the bonspiel is to be changed in that each municipal ward will allocate 10 curlers each and the names for each team will be chosen the morning of the bonspiel. There is to be a maximum of 16 teams with the remaining 4 curlers curlers required being from company representatives or employees or councillors. The bonspiel is to be a 3 game event with each game being 4 ends and the winners being determined by a point system.
