

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular meeting at 9:00 A.M. on Thursday, July 10th, 1986 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Dan Thiessen presided.

Present were Councillors: George St. Hilaire, W. F. Recksiedler, Dave Waldner, Larry Gluck, Glenn Curdt.

- Minutes Moved by W. F. Recksiedler, Seconded by Dave Waldner:
#140/86. Resolved that the minutes of the June 12th, 1986 regular meeting be now adopted as presented. Carried.
- P.Hiebert Moved by W. F. Recksiedler, Seconded by Dave Waldner:
Subdivis. #141/86. Whereas Peter H. Hiebert applied for subdivision in the
NW 10-4-2W NW ¼ of Section 10-4-2 West given planning file no. 36-84-2391;
And Whereas the subdivision has been approved by Council;
And Whereas there is a proposed revision to the subdivision to
have the lot size increased from 5.3 acres to 7 acres;
Therefore Be It Resolved that the Council of the Rural Municipality
of Morris has no objections to this revision and gives approval to the
subdivision as it is amended. Carried.
- Resolution Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:
to M.P.'s #142/86. Be It Resolved that the R. M. of Morris makes its
concerns regarding the farming industry situation to M.P.'s Hon.
Jake Epp and Hon. Jack Murta to the effect that whereas the
municipality:
-appreciated the governments contribution in effecting freight
rate freezes;
-acknowledges the increase in gas tax exemption for agricultural
purposes;
-recognizes the efforts made to improve F.C.C. financing:
the Municipality of Morris expresses grave concern over the reduction
in the price of wheat and other cereal grains and commodities in
general and would request Mr. Epp and Mr. Murta to do whatever
possible to improve the situation. Carried.
- Frog Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Glenn Curdt:
Follies #143/86. Resolved that Reeve Dan Thiessen or an alternate be
authorized to attend the Frog Follies in St. Pierre on
August 3, 1986. Carried.
- Delegation Mr. Glenn McKnight met with Council regarding Court action that he
is involved in which concerns his financial situation and the
possible need for temporary assistance. He is a skilled machinist
and works for Standard Manufacturing. He is currently on a work
sharing program with the company. He explained his situation to
Council and following questions on the matter the delegation ended
and he was advised by Council that they would decide later as to
his request for financial assistance.

Council then discussed at some length the matter of the liability
legal suit against the municipality by Mrs. Adella Thiessen.

Council then recessed for lunch at 12:00 noon to reconvene at
approximately 1:00 P.M.
- Delegation Mr. Dick Heinrichs appeared before Council on behalf of his
subdivision application and Councils request that the lot be
increased in size. He informed Council that the new owners do not
want to give up any additional land other than that stated in the
subdivision application. He asked if it would be approved if it was
50 feet wider, rather than the dimensions requested by Council.
Mr. Heinrichs is to again approach the new owners to see what
additional land they would agree to add to the lot size.

Delegation Mr. Ken Gowler of Armco Westeel Ltd. met with Council to discuss the crossing at Mr. Walter Fraese's which was destroyed by spring waters. This is at the SW corner of Section 26-6-1West. Mr. Gowler gave council prices of three different sizes of culvert which could be placed at this location and he indicated that the cost of having the pipe installed would likely be about \$15,000.00 above the cost of the culvert. At this time, there was no decision by Council on the matter.

 Carried.

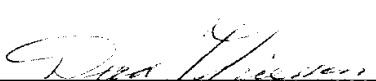
Fire Hall Painting Moved by Dave Waldner, Seconded by Larry Gluck:
