

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held a Special meeting at 7:30 P.M. on Tuesday, July 17, 1990 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Dan Thiessen presided.  
Present were Councillors: George St. Hilaire, Allan Dickson, Bill Martens, Glenn Curdt, Harold Dyck.

The purpose of this meeting is to meet with the U.V.D. of Rosenort Committee to discuss the needed repairs to the Rosenort lagoon and also the results of the flouridation survey sent to Rosenort water consumers.

Also discussed at this meeting were matters of other concerns which were agreed to by Council.

Also present at this meeting were Mr. Art Friesen and Mr. Jim Heinrichs representing the U.V.D of Rosenort Committee.

Council and the U.V.D. Committee discussed the report from J. R. Cousin Consultants regarding the situation at the Rosenort lagoon and the type of additional lagoon cell which should be constructed.

The Manitoba Water Services Board has been contacted requesting financial assistance for the construction of this additional lagoon cell.

Council and the Committee expressed some concern over the recommended sizes of the proposed lagoon cell which are in the report. It was felt that an additional lagoon cell of a smaller size would be more appropriate.

At the time of the meeting, the cost of repairing the cell wall is unknown and this cost estimate would be hopefully available within the next few days.

The general consensus of Council and the Committee is that the repair not be done if at all possible and that an additional cell be added to the lagoon.

There was also discussion on the financing of such undertakings as the cell wall repair and the construction of the new cell.

Council and the U.V.D. Committee then reviewed the survey questionnaire results from the survey on the installation of a flouride treatment for the Rosenort water system. There were approximately 50% of the survey questionnaires returned and of those returned, approximately 63% were in favor of those results returned.

It was decided to check further into the aspects of having flouridation in the water system and that the matter would be further reviewed at a later date.


Council then discussed the matter of culverts needed and it was decided that the needed culverts would be ordered as they will be needed as soon as possible.

Council also discussed the aspects of the search for a 3 ton truck and what progress has been made to date on this matter.

Council also had a short discussion on the subject of renting a tractor unit to be used for mowing our road allowances.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:50 P.M.
