Moved by Leo Kornelsen, Seconded by Barry Fraese:

#162/00. Whereas the R. M. of Morris held a public meeting recently concerning the proposed community dyke for Riverside, Manitoba;

And Whereas the Municipal share of the proposed dyke is to be approximately \$72,000.00 and after allowed credits, the net amount of cost to the local area is approximately \$51,000.00;

And Whereas the consensus of the meeting was to proceed with the dyke project and to also pay for the local share of the dyke on a prepayment basis based on assessment;

Therefore Be It Resolved that the Province of Manitoba be instructed to proceed with the Riverside dyke project with all due speed and that the local ratepayers shall pay their share of the dyke costs on a prepayment concept with the individuals portion depending on the assessed value of the property.

#167/00. Resolved that the R. M. of Morris express our apposition to the proposed Bill 42 of the Government of Manitoba.


