The purpose of the meeting was for the Council to consider the advisability of advancing enough money to C. C. Anderson to enable him to purchase a Dredge to do work for the municipality said money to be repaid from earnings of machine.

After a thorough discussion the following resolution was passed moved by Councillor Irvine seconded by Heppner.

That this Council is in favor of advancing to C. C. Anderson the necessary amount to purchase a Dredge as per his proposition put before this Council in his letter of July 9th 1928. That the Council to have second mortgage on the Dredge until the amount so advanced is paid. That the Collector draw up the agreement or whatever documents are necessary to comply with said arrangements.
