

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Mayor and Councillors Irvine, Carl, Jenkins, Herbert Hoopner & Reboisy.

The minutes of last regular meeting and special meeting held July 11th were read and declared adopted as read. Several delegations were present.

A party from Spurling district asked for a culvert through the grade East of Sec 7-6-20. The Mayor and Councillor Reboisy agreed to look into the matter.

A delegation from the district south and west of the town represented by Messrs. Hornstein and Loewen presented a petition asking for a Draining system consisting of two ditches the petitioners agreeing to pay one half the cost of same. Moved by Councillor Carl seconded by Jenkins.

That the Clerk be instructed to call for tenders for the excavation of a drain according to the petition from the Kate Payas of this district where they pay 1/2 cost of same. Tenders to be in as soon as Engineer finds what the yardage is.

A delegation were present from Aubigny & Morris district and stated that De Lalaberry & Co. were agreeable to pay one half the cost of the off take ditch running to the Morris river from Sec 7-6-26. Moved by Councillor Herbert seconded by Jenkins.

That the Clerk be instructed to write the De Lalaberry & Co. Council re the payment of the cost of construction of a ditch through Sec 7-6-36 so as to provide an outlet for the water on the boundary between De Lalaberry and Morris and that the Clerk get a satisfactory reply then he is to call for tenders said tenders to be in by next regular meeting providing the owners of the land give their permission for the said draining.

A delegation consisting of Messrs. Elliott & J. Whitehead interviewed Council re Dudge ditch they offered to pay one half the cost of same.

The Council agreed to have the levels taken and the work done on this basis.

Mr. Rorner interviewed Council regarding a culvert near section 24-4-10 and asked permission to have the same removed. The Council agreed to have a look at same before agreeing.
