That by Law No 451 being a by law for the purpose of levying a special tax on certain lands for drainage purposes having been read the first time be now considered as having been read the second and third time and passed and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the same. (Carried)

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The Clerk laid a list of the lands in the Municipality liable to be sold for arrears of taxes on the table moved by Councillor Jenkins
seconded " Keppner

That whereas the Council has submitted a list of all lands within the Municipality so liable to be sold for arrears of taxes, pursuant to the Statutes, and whereas the Council desires that a sale of land for taxes be held, now therefore the Council directs the Reeve in his discretion to take all proper proceedings as required by Statute to levy and collect said taxes by sale at the earliest possible moment and further for any reason sufficient buyers are not present at the sale to purchase the different parcels, the Reeve is hereby authorized and instructed to purchase the said parcels in the name of the Rural Municipality.
