

SEP 21 1928

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Reeve and councillors Irvine Carl Jenkins Hebert Heppner & Ribordy.

The minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

Peter Gosson interviewed Council re culvert through ~~grass~~ ditch bank at Sec 33-5-16 Councillor Carl advised him the same would be ordered.

Mr. Leisolin interviewed Council regarding clean out work in the Nelson Drain re advised the Council if the same was done the Ratepayers who ~~are~~ ^{would} be benefited would be willing to pay half the cost.

He was asked to present a petition signed by the Ratepayers to that effect.

Messrs Quinn, Fraser, & Irvine again interviewed the Council about the ditch across their lots. The Reeve advised them that the engineer would make a survey of same and report and if same could be done by the small grade the work would be proceeded with.

The question of deepening the ditch between sections 31 and 32, 29 and 30 and 1/2 mile between 19 & 20 - 4-16 with the Dredge when same was through on the Howe road was discussed and Councillor Irvine was instructed to have same done.

It was decided to have the Northern drain run straight south to the Centre which enters the Morris river instead of leading across section 27-5-16.

Mr. Code interviewed Council regarding a grant to the Morris Agricultural Society.

Mr. Rosner again interviewed the Council regarding the culvert put in the grade between his farm and the Wicks farm the Council advised him that the Engineer would inspect same and report to the Council.

Mr. R. Lewis interviewed Council regarding a bridge on the road Allowance south of lots 37. It was decided to leave same until spring.

A tender of 23 cents per cubic yard was received from H. P. Sheppard on the Hebert Drain but was not accepted.

the question of postponing the Tax Sale until a later date was discussed and the following resolution passed moved by Councillor Irvine seconded " McPherson

That the Tax Sale as advertised be herewith postponed until a later date.

A large delegation representing the flooded area district around Sperling together with their solicitor interviewed the Council regarding what steps would be taken to recompense the farmers for their losses.

The question was very thoroughly gone over and it was decided that the Reeve should get in touch with the Reeves of Roland, Dufferin & McDonald and arrange a meeting with the Government regarding the losses.

Bills and accounts amounting to \$10,275.⁴⁶ were handed to the Finance Committee the Finance Committee reported the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor Robert seconded " Rivordy

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts
