

OCT 19 1928

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Reeve and Councillors Irvine, Carl Jenkins, Heppner & Sibordy.

The minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

A delegation were present asking for a cut-off ditch through Sec 6 - 6 - 36 the Council informed the delegation that if the work could be done for 19 cents the Council would be satisfied to have same done.

Mr. Chisolen and St. Molloy approached the Council regarding the deepening of a ditch near section 14-5-26 they said the work could be done with local teams the Council instructed them to have the work done.

Mr. Stratton asked the Council to have a ditch near Sec 24-5-26 deepened to carry off the surplus water the Reeve advised him he would go over and inspect the same and if local teams could be secured the work would be carried on.

A request was received from P. Berkeple asking for the bonus which was withheld from his son to be paid him the Council would not agree to this.

The matter of the fill at the Lawrie & Kostian Bridge was discussed and the Clerk was instructed to advise Lawrie & Kostian to do the work.
