

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Reeve and Councillors Irvine, Carl Jenkins Neppner & Ribordy.

The minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

Several communications were read and ordered filed the question of adding penalty to taxes was discussed moved by Councillor Ribordy seconded " Neppner

That the Reeves be hereunto instructed not to add the 10% penalty on the 1928 taxes until the next regular meeting or otherwise instructed. (Carried)

Mr Hebert interviewed the Council in regard to paying 25 cents per day to the Old Folks Home at Bonifay towards the keep of Miss Linnard. moved by Councillor Jenkins seconded " Carl

That this Council was in favor of giving a grant of Twenty Five cents a day for the support of Miss Linnard at a Sisters Old Folks Home at St Bonifay (Carried)

Fred Waite interviewed Council in regard to paying of Board of men while some were quarantined at Bonifay

The Council advised him to take the matter up with St. Francis of Winnipeg to ascertain if the municipality were responsible.

Reeve Doney was asked to vacate the chair and Councillor Jenkins was appointed chairman and the following motion was proposed moved by ~~Councillor~~ Ribordy seconded " Irvine

That a grant of One Hundred and Seventy Five Dollars be given Reeve Doney as a token of appreciation for his services for the year 1928. (Carried)

Reeve Doney was called in and presented with the cheque by Councillor Jenkins he thanked the Council for the grant and cooperation they had given him during the past year.
