A letter was received from Manitoba Good Roads Association asking for the names of the Committee appointed moved by Councillor Reberdy seconded " Hebert

That Reeve Stoney and Councillors Clubb and Swarr be appointed as representatives of this Municipality to the Good Roads Association and that the Reeve Act on the Resolution (Carried)

moved by Councillor Hebert seconded " Braun

That the assessment roll of 1920 be adopted as the Assessment roll for the year 1931 and the Council meet as a Court of Revision on Wednesday the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March to hear any complaint received according to Act (Carried)

It was discussed about painting the ferries. moved by Councillor Reberdy seconded " Braun

That the Clerk call for tenders for scraping and painting the Union Point and Silver Plains ferries (Carried)

Mr Gratton interviewed Council in regard to the purchase of bridge plank he was asked to submit prices delivered F.O.B. mores.

A report on relief was read by the Clerk and submitted by Councillors Braun and Nurse Johnson it was decided to leave the matter in the hands of Councillor Braun.

Mr Lewis interviewed the Council in regard to damage done by trespassing on his land during high water the Council agreed to look into the matter at a later date.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee the Finance Committee reported that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.
