Mrs. West of Weston Steel products interviewed Council regarding the sale of culverts the Council stated if they were in need of any culverts during the season they would keep the Company in mind.

Mr. Truison interviewed Council regarding a grade promised south of section 22-6-16. The Council agreed if it were at all possible the work would be done during the season.

The Grand Printing Co submitted a price of 8 1/2 cents per name for printing the Voters list the price seemed agreeable to the Council.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee the Finance Committee reported the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list. moved by Councillor Braun seconded " Hebert

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and the Reeve and the Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried
