

APR 17 1931

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Rev and Councillors Schebb. Suar. Stevenson Hebert. Braum & Reboidy

The minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

A petition was received from the Rappayes south of Lowerform asking for a 18 foot extension on two bridges the matter was discussed and the Revue agreed to go with Councillor Brown and look over the work.

Representations from Canada Bayot Lunko and Holt Caterpillar Co. intervened Council regarding purchase of road machinery but the Revue stated that they would not be in the market for any this season.

A communication was read from P. Gauthier asking permission to rent the road allowance between sections River Lots 464 - 466 as this was a blind road allowance running from highway to the River the following resolution was passed

That this Council rent the road allowance between Lots 464 & 466 from the highway to the river to Pierre Gauthier for the sum of five dollars per year

A request was received from the Lakeheadns Aid Society asking for a grant after a discussion

That a grant of 25.⁰⁰ be given to the Lakeheadns Aid Society of Winnipeg.

Two applications were received from parties asking for seed grain the Council informed them that they were not furnishing any this season.

A letter was received from P. Kewin asking for the position of caretaker of the fire engine at Sperdyig but the Council decided it was not necessary to have a caretaker at the present time.

P. H. Rinner forwarded a request for a grade along side of Sec 19-4-20 offering to do the work if the Municipality would pay the 1/2 cost repairs the Council decided that they could not grant his request.

A communication was received from G. C. Anderson re grading for the season the clerk was instructed to advise him

That there would be very little work done this season
 A letter was received from Department of Public works ^{with} plan of
 road at Union Point it being necessary to pass a resolution in connection
 with same. It was

That whereas this Council has had a survey
 made of part of lot 519 Parish of St Agathe for the purpose of establishing a
 public road from Lord Selkirk Highway to Union Point Station

And whereas a copy of said survey or plan
 has been registered in Winnipeg and Titles Office on February 23.
 A.D. 1931 as plan No. 3490

Now therefore this Council in session declares
 this road as described in plan No. 3490 a public road or highway.
 (Carried)

The repairing of the road between Lots 269-2371 was discussed
 and it was decided to have a survey made of same and call
 for tenders for the work.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee the
 Finance Committee reports the Treasurer is hereby authorized
 to pay accounts as per list

seconded " Hebert

That the report of the Finance Committee
 be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue
 cheques for the several accounts.
