A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date. Present: Reeve and Councillors Lebb, Snow, Alverton, Robert Brown & Ribordy. Minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

Communications were read from

Department of Health re immunization of school children also new revision of Rubella Health Service

Peere Smith re rental of road allowance. The Council decided to lease same for a period of five years.

The Clerk introduced a proposition from J. B. Barrett of Spelling re purchase of store

seconded " Alverton

That this Council accept the offer of J. B. Barrett as submitted for store property and Lot 3 & 4 Block 10 plan 916 and the Clerk be instructed to have agreement drawn up. Carried.

The following Old Age pensions were recommended by Council

That this Council recommend the applications of W. H. Taylor of Union Point and Agnes Krocker of Lone Farm for old age pension

By Law No 478 was introduced and read a first time

moved by Councillor Lebb.

seconded " Snow

That By Law No 478 being a by law for the purpose of regulating and control of dogs in the Village of Spelling having been read the first time be now considered as read the second and third time and passed and that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the same (Carried)

The matter of appointing a constable and dog tax collector for the Town of Spelling was discussed and the following motion was passed

moved by Councillor Ribordy

seconded " Robert

That Matt Latham of Spelling be appointed constable and dog tax collector for the Town of Spelling and that the collector be paid 1<sup>st</sup> per head for each dog license collected. (Carried)

Representatives of Salvation Army interviewed Council regarding grant after a discussion the following resolution was passed.

That a grant of 150<sup>00</sup> be given to the Salvation Army  
of Winnipeg for year 1931

Dr Roy Health Officer spoke to the Council about having the balance  
of the children in the schools immunized.

The Council agreed to have the work done and instructed him to do the  
work.

The question of repairing road east of Section 29-6-20 was discussed  
and the Clerk was instructed to write Engineer Irvine regarding  
same.

The matter of installing a crushed stone spillway on road south  
of Lane farm was taken up and the Clerk was instructed to  
get in touch with Engineer Dempster regarding same.

Bills and accounts were presented to the Finance Committee  
the Finance Committee reported the Treasurer is hereby authorized  
to pay the accounts as per list

Moved by Councillor Reave  
Seconded " Stewart

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted  
and the Reave and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the  
several amounts

Carried
