A special meeting of the Council was called by Rev. Stoney on the above date to discuss and pass resolutions in connection with the Unemployment Relief work.

The matter discussed was the work to be performed after a decision it was decided upon and the following resolution passed. Moved by Councillor Stevenson seconded "L. Clubb.

That owing to the number of unemployed who have registered in this Municipality for relief work, the Council are of the opinion that work of this nature should be carried on, and hereby make application to the Department of Public Works to have the following work performed, as soon as approved by the Department and paid for on the following basis. That is to say Dominion Government pay 50%, Provincial Government 20% and Municipality 20% of cost.

- Projects
- No. 1. Spring road commencing at Carman Highway No. 3, R.C. 29-6-20 and continuing South West to the Village of Spring, then due West connecting with Spring Home Road, West of Sec 29-6-20
 - No. 2. The boundary ditch extending along the boundary between Krouse and Rhineland Municipalities a distance of approximately 10 miles
 - No. 3. A drainage ditch commencing on River Lot 435 and continuing north to Lot 463 a distance of about 2 miles
 - No. 4. A Drainage ditch between sections 23 and 24 and 20 and 26 in Township Six Range 1, East
 - No. 5. Clearing out road ditches north of River Lot 448 a distance of approximately 2 miles.
 - No. 6. The cutting of brush in different parts of the Municipality where it interferes with Roads or Drainage. (Carried)

Regarding wages to be paid the following resolution was passed moved by Councillor Ribordy seconded "L. Clubb

That the schedule of wages to be paid by this Municipality on Unemployment Relief work be as follows.

	Rate per hour
Labours on road work	25 cents per hour
Teamsters with 2 horses	45 " " "
Teamsters with 4 horses	65 " " "

and that a copy of this resolution be submitted to the Department of Public Works for approval. (Carried)

After the Clerk was instructed to forward copies of these resolutions to the Department of Public Works the meeting adjourned.
