Communications were read from A. Macnamara Asst Deputy Minister re freight on wood, and ordered filed

Also from Gen Permanent Miss. Sec. and A. Christie re refund of penalty on 1920 lines the Council ~~advised~~ <sup>instructed</sup> the Clerk to advise the parties that they were unable to grant their request.

Mr Scott of Sperting wrote the Council regarding clothes. Mr Abirdy was instructed to take care of the matter.

A letter was received from Red Cross Society asking for a donation <sup>Relief</sup> for but the Council thought it would be necessary to look after their own relief first

The Revue advised the Council of the arrangement made with McDonald Municipality re cost of car in connection with the district nurse he stated that McDonald Municipality agreed to pay \$12<sup>00</sup> per month for use of car and the allowance received from the Department would take care of the Gas and oil.

Used Inspector Brown gave a report of his work during the past month.

By Law 482 was read a first time moved by Councillor Chubb

That By Law No 482 being a by law for the purpose of providing for the nomination and election of a Revue and three Councillors for the ensuing term having been read a first time be now considered as read a second and third time and passed and the Revue and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the same

Application for old age pension was received from Arthur L. Bennett <sup>Corried</sup> after a discussion it was moved Councillor Stevenson seconded Robert

That the application of Arthur L. Bennett for old age pension be recommended. <sup>Corried</sup>

Mr J. Kelly of Res 8-5-100 asked the Council for a ditch along side of Dump across the north side of Belins 7-8-99. The Revue advised him that the matter would be taken up with the Drainage Department.

The Council were advised that work could be proceeded with under the Unemployment Relief measures

The following resolution was passed regarding the Low Rate

That Whereas the Secretary Treasurer has submitted a list of all lands within the Municipality so liable to be sold for arrears of taxes, pursuant to the Statutes, and whereas the Council desires that a sale of land for taxes be held.

Now therefore the Council directs the Reeve in his discretion to take all proper proceedings as required by the Statutes to levy and collect said taxes by sale at the earliest possible moment, and further if for <sup>any reason</sup> sufficient buyers are not present at the sale to purchase the different parcels, the Reeve is hereby authorized and instructed to purchase the said parcels in the name of the Municipality.
