

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Reeve and Councillors Lebb, Surr, Sturson, Hebert and Brown the minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read a delegation consisting of Mr Lewis and Mr Conventon representing the Morris Bridge Area interviewed the Council requesting that a member of the Council be appointed to join their Committee to meet the Municipal Commission at a later date regarding the levy on the Bridge District

moved by Councillor Hebert
seconded " Sturson

That Reeve Stoney be appointed to represent the Council at a meeting to be held at Winnipeg in connection with Morris Bridge Area (carried)

Messrs Lebb and Moody interviewed Council regarding a grant to the Agricultural Society they stated that on account of weather conditions the Fair had a deficit of about 400.⁰⁰ after a discussion the following resolution was passed.

moved by Councillor Hebert
seconded " Lebb

That a grant of 350.⁰⁰ be given to the Morris Agricultural Society (carried)

Notes of meeting of Union of Manitoba Municipalities was read and the following delegates were appointed.

moved by Councillor Sturson
seconded " Surr

That Councillors Hebert, Lebb and Reeve Stoney be appointed delegates to attend Union of Manitoba Municipalities Convention and that the Reeve be appointed a voting delegate (carried)

a communication was received from P. H. Penner asking for relief the matter was left over for investigation

a letter was received from Old Age Pension Branch re application of William Taylor the Clerk was instructed to return application stating that the Council could not see their way clear to recommend same

a letter was received from L. L. Johnson regarding damage to car caused by condition of road the Clerk was instructed to advise him that the road was under construction and a proper crossing was made to leave the road but he did not use same.

Letter was received from L. L. Lamy regarding property in Leaside asking for extension of time before Municipality made application for title the Council agreed to this if it did not prejudice their rights.

a communication was received from P. H. Kumer asking for Balance on account amounting to \$12⁰⁰ also relief the matter was left in abeyance.

The financial statement of the Community Bank at Spurling was read and ordered filed.

Kumer Brown & Kumer of Spurling spoke to the Council regarding the levy in connection with the Spurling Bank they stated that the levy was heavier on the farm lands than the ~~the~~ Spurling property and wished to have same adjusted.

The Kumer stated that the matter would be adjusted another year when the levy was made.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee the committee reported that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list moved by committee Brown seconded. Robert

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and the Kumer and Robert be authorized to issue checks for the several accounts
