A petition was received from J. C. Magar and several others asking

That this Council approve of the Petition forwarded
by J. C. Magar asking Sec 35-36-3-1-w and Sec 31-3-1-c to De Wet S. D. and if
arbitration is necessary that Mr James Clubb be appointed Arbitrator

Mr P. S. Penner and Krocker again interviewed the Council regarding relief they were advised that their case would be investigated Mrs John White also asked for clothing etc she was referred to the District Nurse for a report.

A communication was received from Messrs. M. Black & M. Aubrey asking that the Council would application for title in the No 13-4-200 until their clients were able to receive the proceeds of 1932 crop they agreed to return the No. 12-4-200 if the Council would grant their request re No. 13-4-200. After a discussion the Council agreed to their request.

Mr Johnson of Spelling interviewed Council regarding Hospital account and Doctors account he stated that he was injured during the work on the unemployment Relief and did not receive sufficient money for the work to take care of the account. He was of the opinion that compensation should be given to him.

It was advised that it was not necessary to carry compensation when the Municipality was performing the work by hired labor and not by contract.

The Reeve was asked to vacate the chair and Councillor Rebody was appointed chairman and the following resolution was passed moved by Councillor Shovier seconded by Robert

That the Reeve Mr G. L. Stony be paid the sum of 167⁰⁰ for services rendered during the year 1931

Carried

The Reeve was then called in and presented with the cheque he thanked the Council for the grant and also for the cooperation received from the Council during the past year. He also stated that he wished to take this opportunity of thanking the retiring Councillor Mr Braum for services rendered during the past term of his office and wished him health and prosperity in the future.

Bills and accounts were handed to the finance committee the finance committee reported the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

That the report of the finance committee be accepted and the Reeve and the Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried.
