

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Warden and Councilors Messrs. Luan. Alvinson Herbert Thuesen & Ribordy. The minutes of former meeting held April 15th were read and declared adopted as read.

Communications were read from the L. F. Leo Association re prices on lumber Prices Pole & Supply Leo re prices on Cedar Piling etc and filed.

A copy of the Act re consolidation of areas of Taxes was laid on the table after a discussion of same the following resolution was passed moved by Councilor Ribordy seconded " Thuesen

That the Clerk be instructed to prepare a by-law for the purpose of consolidating areas of taxes.

The question of reimbursement re expenses of different school districts was discussed and the following resolution passed moved by Councilor Ribordy seconded " Olcott.

That the Secretary be instructed to advise the different school boards of the importance of cutting out all unnecessary expense in connection with the operation of the schools.

Major Baker of the Salvation Army interviewed Council regarding a grant to the Army he stated financial condition of Grace Hospital also stated that no accounts for patients had ever been submitted to the Council since the Council commenced giving a grant.

After a lengthy discussion the following resolution was passed moved by Councilor Herbert seconded " Alvinson

That a grant of 100⁰⁰ be given to the Salvation Army. (Carried)

on account of the great many requests received for grants to different organizations the following resolution was passed. moved by Councilor Luan seconded " Herbert

That this Council discontinue all grants until such time as the financial condition of the Municipality becomes normal. (Carried)

Mr. Loh spoke to the Council regarding condition of the wall east of his place also asked for a culvert through the grade between sections 23 and 26 - 5-2 E. Councilor Herbert was asked to investigate the matter.

The condition of the floor of the Red River Mill bridge was brought up and the matter is to be investigated by the Council and repaired.

The question of repairing bridges East of line 4-5-1 E and to 5-5-1 W was brought up and the Clerk was instructed to get in touch with the Engineer of the Drainage Department to see what could be done in connection with same.

As the system established by the Department of Health last year in connection with District Nurses seemed to be unsatisfactory to the Council the following resolution was passed.

That this Council protest the hiring of a district nurse under the present system.

'Carried'

A request was read from Mr Kolette for a grade on road allowance between Lots 495 and 497 to connect with bridge erected last fall the matter was left in abeyance.

The Clerk was asked to write Good Roads Department re the completion of road at Spurling commenced last fall.

Bills and Accounts were handed to the Finance Committee the Finance Committee reported the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.
