

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Clerk and Councilors Messrs. Stevenson, Robert Thieson & Ribordy.

The minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

Mr H H Thieson of Low Farm interviewed Council in regard to the purchase of the lot 25-5-2w after a discussion the following resolution was passed

That the lot 25-5-2w be sold to H. H. Thieson of Low Farm for the sum of 800.⁰⁰ a cash payment of 25.⁰⁰ to be paid this fall. (Carried)

Mr G. East interviewed Council in connection with a grade east of section 31-6-1w he offered to do the work and have the cost credited on the taxes. It was finally agreed to allow him to do construct 1/2 mile of grade with ditches on both sides 18 inches deep for the sum of \$60.⁰⁰

Mr Weiss of Low Farm interviewed the Council in connection with the F. Thieson family he stated that he was unable to work and was in need of assistance. The Council agreed to investigate the case.

A request was received from Mr W. J. Savine for a culvert to be replaced east of Sec 17-4-1 E. The Council agreed to have the work done.

Mr Jackson spoke to the Council in connection with work of the Public Health Department.

Mr Heppner interviewed the Council in connection with the Martin D. Wiebe family he stated Mr Wiebe was suffering from typhoid and unable to work and that the family needed assistance.

The Council advised that Mr Wiebe be sent to the hospital to be cured and that the Council look after the family in the meantime.

Mr O'Loole a party who lost an hand in a accident last fall spoke to the Council regarding some assistance as he was unable to find work. He stated that Mr Hollett was unable to keep him without cost of having being paid.

Councilor Stevenson was instructed to make arrangements in connection with the case.
