

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date at 1. P.M. present the Reeve and Councillors Blubb, Inarr, Plummer, Hebert, Thruen and Ribordy.

The minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

Mr Bestwick noxious weed inspector gave a report of his work so far and after a discussion it was decided that he take three weeks off in the latter part of August and work three weeks in September this was thought advisable in connection with the looking after the roadways.

The Public works levy for the year 1932 was discussed and the following resolution passed.

That the public works levy for the year 1932 be set at 3 mills on the dollar. Carried.

By Law 494

By Law No 494 was then read a first time

That By Law 494 being a by law for the purpose of levying and collecting rates for the year 1932 having been read the first time be now considered as having been read the second and third time and passed and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the same Carried

The Clerk informed the Council that he had disposed of all the farm lands that the Municipality had title for at the price of \$15⁰⁰ per acre terms as a grant upon by the Council. the following resolution was then passed.

That this Council authorize the sale of section six in Township Six Range One west to G.H. Cline & D.H. Cline and the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty five in Township Five Range Two West to Jacob Berhan and the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty Three in Township Five Range Two west to Edward Gruning and that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign the articles of agreement on behalf of the Municipality Carried

A petition was presented to the Council by Messrs Hornstein and Train and signed by Twenty four School Boards asking that the school year for the Municipality be reduced from 10 months to 9 months

after a discussion of the subject the following resolution was passed.

That this Council recommend to the Department of Education that the school year be reduced from ten months to nine months.
(Carried)

A delegation composed of Messrs. Giffels and Barrett of Spurling interviewed the Council in regard to having the Dog Law in the village of Spurling either removed altogether or if that was impossible to have same lowered.

After a thorough discussion of the matter the following resolution was passed.

seconded " Stevenson

That the Dog Law as stated in by Law 478 which is "3rd" and "5th" be reduced to "1st" and "2nd".
(Carried)

A complaint was received in connection with the noise of vacant land not ~~taking~~ proper precautions in connection with the control of the grasshopper situation and it was decided that where the cooperation was not satisfactory the Municipality would have to look after the spreading of the poison.

The following resolution was passed
moved by councillor Reboody
seconded " Stevenson

That the clerk notify owners of vacant lands that the ~~cost~~ cost of spreading of grasshopper poison will be charged against the land.
(Carried)

In regard to the survey of the Village of Aubigny the clerk was instructed to make arrangements to have the same done at an early date.

Communications were read from Leheld Wilford M.D. of Dept. Children Public Health Dept. Re Municipal Car.

The meeting held July 6. Resolutions and communications were ordered filed.

Bills and accounts were handed to the finance committee the finance committee reported the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.
