

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Wren and Wardens Lebb. Suar, Thurman, Hebert, Thies and H. Borley

The minutes of former regular meeting held Sept. 16th and special meetings held Sept 24th and Oct 10 were read and declared adopted as read. The first order of business was the appointment of Health Officer to fill vacancy caused by Dr Roy of St. Jean leaving the district. After a discussion ~~of~~ of the subject it was moved by Councillor Stevenson seconded by " Swan

That Dr Ross be appointed Health Officer to complete appointment vacated by Dr Roy (Carried) 8-0-0

Mr. B. Luak interviewed Council in connection with account of \$50⁰⁰ claimed for wages for the time his girl worked for Mrs M. V. White after a discussion the Council agreed to allow this amount to be credited on his feed grain note.

Mr J. J. Lewis interviewed Council in connection with his feed and seed grain notes and also asked for flour. The Council could not agree to his request at the present time of furnishing flour.

Mr. Rustick spoke to the Council in connection with his fees for collection of seed and feed grain notes. He stated he had collected about 6.400⁰⁰ and had not been on the work since the first week in October.

Mrs H. H. Lusin and Jacob Braun interviewed Council in connection with payments due on agreements of sale. They explained that at the present time they were unable to pay on account but had made considerable improvements in the way of plowing etc. The Council agreed to carry the payment over until later on.

It was decided to do ~~some~~ a mile of grade in Ward 5 and to employ those owning Municipality for relief.

It was moved by Councillor Lebb seconded by " Swan

That Councillor Lusin be appointed to oversee relief work in Ward 5. (Carried)

The Clerk explained that the C¹/₂ of Block 1, Plan 522 had been sold in Lot sale of 1930 as Lots 1 to 5, Blk 1. as there was not any lots in this block it would be necessary to redeem same from sale and add to streets.

Moved by Councillor Lusin seconded by " Hebert

That C¹/₂ of Block 1, Plan 522 be taken from Lot sale of 1930 and ~~added~~ placed back in Roll. (Carried)

A letter was read from Union of Manitoba Municipalities stating that the convention would be held in Winnipeg on 6th & 7th December and asked that delegates be appointed and membership paid moved by Councillor Helbert seconded - Stevenson

That membership fee of 20⁰⁰ to Union of Manitoba Municipalities be paid and that Revue Doney and Councillors Snarr & Lheim be appointed delegates to Union of Manitoba Municipalities Convention and that Revue Doney be a voting delegate.

(Carried)

By-Law No 497 was read a first time

That By-Law No 497 being a by-law for the purpose of electing a Revue and three Councillors for wards 1, 2, & 4, for Municipality of Morris for year 1933. having been read the first time be now considered as having been read the second and third time and passed and that the Revue and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the same

The question of building sawmills at Aubigny was discussed and Councillor Helbert was instructed to have same built one half of cost to be borne by the Parish.

A letter was read from Social Hygiene asking for grant which the Council were unable to grant.

Communications were received from Trusts Loan Co of Canada asking for refund of possession on 25-6-16 the Council were unable to grant request. also from Monarch Life Assurance Co asking permission to pay one years bonus after property was advertised in for sale. The Clerk was instructed to advise the Company that this was not possible.

Bills and accounts were handed to Finance Committee the Finance Committee reported the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor Lheim
seconded - Rebody

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and that the Revue and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts.
