

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Reeve and all the Councillors.

The minutes of former meeting held Oct 21 were read and declared adopted as read.

Several applications for relief was received and the Council decided to appoint S. H. Bestwick as relief Officer to investigate the circumstances in connection with all applications and report to Council.

Councillor Stevenson reported he had interviewed Mr Larson maker of artificial limbs in regard to a hook for Mr A. Looke and that same could be purchased for the sum of \$65.<sup>00</sup>

a request was received from the Parish of Aubigny asking that the Council pay for the half share of sidewalk belonging to the Parish and wait for one year for the Parish to pay the same back.

That this Council agree to pay this half of sidewalk and carry the Parish for one year on the balance referred to in their letter. (Carried)

Mr Wait interviewed Council in connection with work done grade at horse shoe lake he stated that he had 2/3 of the work completed and asked for payment on account of same.

That L. Wait be paid for 500 yards on the work on road between Morris & Montcalm Municipalities (Carried)

Mr L. Bouchard interviewed Council in regard to an account owing him by J. O. Bourbonniere for crossing ferry amounting to \$11.<sup>25</sup> he stated that he had interviewed Bourbonniere and he had promised to pay him but had never done so. The Council instructed it to let to write the St Boniface Creamery Co in regard to the matter.

A communication was received from Mr Herman Dick of Alloua in connection with the rent of a house by Mr. J. White. Councillor Therien was instructed to look after the matter.

A letter was received from Brandon Tourist Association asking that the Delegates appointed to Union of Manitoba Municipalities Convention use their influence to have next convention held in Brandon.
