

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Clerk and all the Councillors.

The minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted and communications were read from Relief Department & Public works re relief for Jacob Pankratz the above party being in Keldonau Municipality and would be returned to Morris Municipality unless the sum of 15⁰⁰ per mos was guaranteed towards the support of the family.

The Council decided it would be better to pay this amount than have the family returned.

Information was received from the Department in regard to Relief work

A letter was received from the Tax Commission advising the Council that the Assessment Roll had been ~~adopted~~ accepted as the Assessment Roll for the year 1933 and the following resolution was passed moved by Councillor Smar
seconded . Blubb.

Resolved that with the sanction and approval of Tax Commission, the Assessment for the year 1933 made and completed pursuant to the provisions of the Assessment Act and finally revised as the Assessment Roll for the Municipality on the 5th day of March A.D. 1930 be adopted as the Assessment Roll on which the rate of taxation for the year 1933 be fixed and levied. subject to a revision of said Assessment in the manner provided in the Assessment Act. "Carried"

The question of adding penalty to taxes on Dec 16th was discussed and the following resolution passed moved by Councillor Ribordy
seconded . Hebert

That the time for adding penalty on taxes be extended one month.

Applications for old age pension were received from Johann Penner of Lord farm. and James McDonald of Springfield man moved by Councillor Thiesch
seconded . Ribordy

That this Council recommend the application of Johann Penner and James McDonald for old age pension. "Carried."

The usual grant to the Social Service for business losses was discussed and the following resolution passed moved by Councillor Blubb

seconded . Stevenson

That a grant of 30⁰⁰ be given to the social service.

Mr Bistumb interviewed Council in regard to the condition of the
families asking for relief he stated that he had visited 40 families
and had several more applications to attend to. Reports were submitted
on families visited.

The finances of the Municipality were discussed with the Manager
of the local bank and the outlook for the coming year was
gone into. The Manager was instructed to take the matter up later
with the bank and arrange for a line of credit similar to last 1931.

The Reeve Stoney was asked to vacate the chair and Councillor
Rebordy took the chair he advised the Council that it was
customary at this meeting to make a grant to the Reeve in
consideration of the work done by him during the past year
moved by Councillor Stevenson
seconded . . . Hebert

That a grant of 150⁰ be given to Reeve Stoney
for the year 1932.

Reeve Stoney was then called to the chair and presented with the
cheque and in a few well chosen remarks he thanked the Council
for their cooperation during the past year and impressed
upon them the continued diligence in regard to Municipal
matters that of would be necessary during 1933.
