

29 AUG 1934

The Committee met as a Committee of Revision to revise the Tax Roll  
for the year 1935. At 11 AM on the above date present  
the Clerk and Councillors Blubb, Swain, Swain Thesim and  
Rouse. The Assessor explained the methods used in  
connection with the preparing of the Roll.

Several suggestions were submitted by the Council.  
The following resolution was then passed  
moved by Councillor Blubb  
seconded " Swain

That the Collector's Roll as submitted  
be adopted as the Collector's Roll for the year 1935, subject  
to the necessary changes being made by the Assessor  
as authorized by the Council. (Carries)

The meeting then adjourned to meet as a regular -  
at 1. P.M.

The Council reassembled at 1. P.M. and the minutes of  
meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

The Clerk informed the Council that he had acquired  
of 400 acres more of municipal land and submitted  
to be passed in connection with sale of same.

By Law No 535 and 536 were then read a first time  
536 moved by Councillor Swain  
seconded " Thesim

That By Law 535 being a by law for  
purpose of authorizing the sale of the R 1/2 of Sec 16-5-2 W 10 T 6 N  
Former of Lows Farm and By Law 536 authorizing the sale of an  
8 1/2 of R 1/2 of Sec 9-5-2 W 10 Jacob & John Wilsons of Lows Farm  
Having been read the first time be now considered as having  
been read the second and third time and passed. and  
the Clerk and Clerk be authorized to sign the and seal the  
same. (Carried.)

The Clerk advised the Council that a request had been made  
for a statement to be prepared in connection with the taxes from  
the Morris Bridge Area. He stated that information had been  
submitted several times, and if it were agreeable to the Council  
it might be advisable to have a statement prepared by  
the Municipal Auditor and submitted.

Moved by Councillor Swain  
seconded " Blubb

That this Council request the Department  
of the Municipal Commissioners to have the Municipal Auditor prepare  
a statement showing amount collected and how same was used  
in connection with taxes from Bridge Area. (Carries)

Representatives from the Department of Education displayed a map showing the proposed changes in the boundaries of the different School Districts. After an explanation of same the following resolution was passed  
moved by Councillor Soper  
seconded " Thereon

That the plan of reorganization of the School Districts as prepared by the Department of Education be received and that the Clerk be instructed to advise the owners of the different parcels of land effected if any complaint to appear before the Council at the next regular meeting of the Council.  
(Carried)

Mr. Wells representing the Canadian Institute for the Blind interviewed the Council in connection with a grant to that institution. After discussion the following resolution was passed  
moved by Councillor Soper  
seconded " Thereon

That we contribute the sum of 40<sup>00</sup> to the Canadian National Institute for the blind.  
(Carried)

The matter of levelling the earth cleaned out of the ditches by the Anderson Hedge was discussed and the Clerk was instructed to advise the owners of the land from which the soil drifts. that the Council would hold them responsible for the levelling of the drifts.

Several communications were read and ordered filed. Accounts and commissions were handed to the Finance Committee and the Finance committee reported the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the amounts as per list  
moved by Councillor Soper  
seconded " Thereon

That the Finance Committee report be accepted and the Clerk and Clerk issue cheques for the several amounts.  
(Carried)

Resolution in connection with sweepstakes for Hospitals was laid over until later.

The meeting then adjourned.
