A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date. The Reeve and all the members present.

The minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

The question of the formation of a new School District was introduced and after a discussion the following resolution was passed.

Moved by Councillor Swan

Seconded - Glubb.

That a by-law be passed at the next regular meeting of the Council forming a new school district taking land from Rasmussen, Liberty Park, Kebab and Rosendal S. D. and that all ratepayers interested shall be advised before date of meeting. (Carried)

Mr. M. Nielsen of Spudis spoke to the Council in connection with the purchase of C/2 35-6-2w and the W/2 36-6-2w he stated he was willing to pay 8<sup>00</sup> per acre for same.

Moved by Councillor Swan

Seconded - Thiesen

That the C/2 of Sec 35-6-2w and the W/2 Sec 36-6-2w be sold to Mr. M. Nielsen at a price of 8<sup>00</sup> per acre with a cash payment of \$500. (Carried)

Mr. P. H. Lumer spoke to the Council in connection with the balance owing on NW 30-4-2w. he stated he would give \$5<sup>00</sup> cash and pay the 1934 taxes of the Council would give him clear title.

That the NW 30-4-2w be sold to P. H. Lumer at a cash price of \$5<sup>00</sup> per acre and the 1934 taxes

Application for old age pension was received from Louis Loffriere of Arbigny man.

Councillor Swan spoke to the Council in connection with the eradication of the grey hills at Silver Plains he stated he thought it advisable to have two rows of gravel placed on same. after a discussion the following resolution was passed

That Councillor Swain be instructed to make arrangements to secure two cars of gravel, said gravel to be spread on the ferry hill both sides.

Councillor Rance advised the Council that he intended to take a holiday for a period of three months and asked for leave of absence.

Moved by Councillor Clabb  
seconded - Swain

That the Council grant the request of Councillor Rance of spending for three months absence

(Carried)  
The question of arrears of taxes on W. J. Lafferie property was discussed. Councillor Stevenson stated that he was unable to pay same and if the property was sold for taxes and taken from him it would be necessary for the Council to keep him. It was decided to cancel the arrears provided Lafferie would pay the current years taxes each year.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson  
seconded - Swain

That the arrears on W. J. Lafferie property be cancelled.

(Carried)  
Acknowledgement of the Car of vegetables etc shipped to the dried out area was read to the Council.

A letter was received from the Department of Public Works calling the attention of the Council to the condition of the spellway Tobacco Creek Drain. The Councillors were instructed to look after the matter.

A letter was received from the Child Welfare Department advising the Council that they would not recommend the reestablishing of the Martin D. Wiebe family at Home man.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee the Finance Committee recommended reported the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor Rance  
seconded - Swain

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and the Rance and Clabb be authorized to ~~sign~~ issue cheques for the several amounts.
