A special meeting of the Council was held on the above date owing to Reeve Churchill meeting with an accident, and dislocating his shoulder he was unable to attend, all the Councillor's were present.

The meeting was called for the purpose of dealing with the report of the Committee which met the Drainage Commission.

It was moved by Councillor Clubb and seconded by Councillor Stevenson that Councillor Snarr act as Reeve during the meeting. (Carried)

Messrs, Davidson and McNulty asked that they be allowed to address the Council in regard to the drainage question, their request was granted,

After hearing and discussing the report given by the above mentioned they retired and the report of the Committee taht attended the meeting with the Commission was given .

The report was discussed for con siderable time and the following resolution was passed unanimously,

Moved by Councillor Clubb,
Seconded by Councillor Thiesen,

That this Council recommend the acceptance of the offer submitted by the Drainage Commission, in connection with the liabilities of Drainage District No. 2, 6, and 12, with the understanding that in future the Provincial Government pay not less than fifty percent of the cost of maintenance of said system in this Municipality.

(Carried)

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, the Finance Committee reported that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.
