

Morris Man. March 20th. 1936

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date present the Reeve and all the Councillors,

The minutes of former meeting held February 21st, were read and declared adopted as read.

Several applicants were present asking for seed after a discussion the following resolution was passed,

Moved by Councillor Gehring,  
Seconded by Councillor Snarr,

That this Municipality, on account of present conditions reject all applications for seed grain.

( Carried)

An application was received from Messrs, Touchette, Roy and several others asking that a new School District be formed.

Moved by Councillor Thiesen,  
Seconded by Councillor McDonald,

That the application for a new school be received and that the Clerk be instructed to prepare a by-law, for our next regular meeting and send out the necessary notices,

A resolution was read authorizing the Reeve and Sec. Treas, to sign all cheques and notes etc in connection with the Royal Bank of Canada, Carman.

Moved by Councillor Clubb,  
Seconded by Councillor McDonald,

That the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to transact the necessary business for the Municipality in connection with the Royal Bank of Canada, Carman, Man.

The condition of the Road Drags was discussed, and the following resolution was passed  
Moved by Councillor McDonald,

Seconded by Councillor Stevenson,

That Reeve Churchill and Councillor Clubb be appointed a Committee to interview some of the Blacksmiths, in Morris in connection with building a Municipal drag.

( Carried)

The question of the appointment of a different Ferry-man at Union- Point was discussed and the following resolution was passed.

Moved by Councillor Clubb,  
Seconded by Councillor Snarr,

That the resolution appointing Charles Perrault as Ferry-man at Union Point Ferry be rescinded, and that A Berthelette be appointed in his place.

( Carried)

A discussion took place in connection with the building of bridges and ordering material.

Moved By Councillor Snarr,  
Seconded by Councillor Thiesen

That a bridge be built across the Morris River at sec. 17-5-1E. (Carried)

Moved by Councillor Snarr  
Seconded by Councillor Clubb,

That the Clerk be instructed to get prices on steel span for bridge across the river.

( Carried)

Moved by Councillor Stevenson  
Seconded by Councillor McDonald,

That this Council order a car load of cedar piling and bridge timbers to complete the bridge, resolution to be held up for further instructions. (carried)

Bills and accounts were handed to the finance Committee the Finance Committee reported that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay accounts as per list.  
Moved by Councillor Thiesen,

Seconded by Councillor Gehring,

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and that the Reeve and Clerk issue cheques for the several amounts.

( Carried)
