After a discussion the following resolution was passed,
Moved by Councillor Snarr
Seconded by Councillor Clubb,

That the Tender of Jacob Penner be accepted for the building of the bridge at NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 17-5-1E at a price of \$558.30. (Carried)
Several tenders were received for hauling the lumber but it was decided to let P. B. Wiebe haul same if suitable arrangements could be made.
The Clerk was instructed to order the Iron from the Manitoba Bridge and Iron Works Limited, at a price of \$93.00 F.O.B. Morris.
The Clerk was asked to make arrangements for the ropes and pulleys for the Pile Driver, if possible from the Government.
The meeting then adjourned.
