

Morris, Manitoba. June 20th, 1936.

At a special meeting of the Council held on Saturday evening June 20th at which Reeve Churchill and Councillors Snarr, Clubb, McDonald and Stevenson were present, the Council were advised by the Minister of Public Works that the Government was unable to grant the Councils request as stated in former resolution, that is to gravel and maintain the proposed road to Lowe Farm and six miles south towards Rosenfeld, after a discussion the following resolution was passed.

Moved by Councillor Snarr
Seconded by Councillor Clubb,

That this Council is in favor of constructing the grade on the proposed road on a fifty-fifty basis with the Provincial Government said road to be constructed 10 miles west from Morris and 6 miles South on the Rosenfeld road. Work to be done under the supervision of the Department of Public Works.

The meeting then adjourned.
