The Clerk was instructed to call for tenders for the repairing of three bridges and fill in work on the Shannon Creek, Tenders to be in by Saturday October 3rd.

A letter was read from the Board of Health in connection with Infantile Paralysis and the following resolution passed.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson,

Seconded by Councillor Thiesen,

That on and after this date any resident of this Municipality who believes he or any members of his household may be developing Infatile Paralysis, the symptoms of which are, upset stomach, headache, fever, rapid pulse and stiffness of the neck or back, has the right to call his own Doctor at the expense of the Municipality to make a visit to decide what the illness is. If it should be Infantile Paralysis the Municipality will also be responsible for the cost of any further medical attention required. (carried)

The meeting then adjourned.
