Messrs Bessette and Saurette asked the Council to have a ditch improved in their locality, the matter was left with Councillor McDonald.

Messrs. Chisholm and Eidse interviewed the Council in regard to a ditch west of Section 6-6-1W, the Council promised to do the work if at all possible this fall.

A letter was read from Mr. E. Collette of Montreal in connection with the deepening the levels taken and if possible the work done at once.

Several applications for relief were received and the matter left with the local Mr Councillors to investigate.

A letter was read from Manux. Benard, representing the Executors of the Father Desrosiere Estate, asking damages for trees cut on the property. Councillor McDonald advised the Council that the trees cut were on the roadway and not on private property, and the Clerk was instructed to advise Mr. Benard to this effect.
