

November 19, 1936.

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date, present the Reeve and all the Council.

The minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

Mr. Bestwick appeared before Council in connection with a house that Edmond Berthelette purchased from Mr. Mussino and defaulted on payments, after a discussion the Council decided to pay the rent for six months amounting to \$30.00 same to be applied on Berthelettes purchase price and also to assist Mr. Berthelette to move his house from the present site.

The question of J. H. Wiens, transient, living with J. W. Friesen was taken up and it was decided to have Mr. Friesen keep him until such time ~~as~~ as we find out which Municipality was responsible for him.

Messrs. Hebert and Gratton again interviewed the Council in connection with a restricted area for Bees, they were informed that it was necessary to present a petition signed by two thirds of the Bee Keepers before anything could be done.

By-Law No. 576 was read a first time.

That By-Law No. 576 being a by-law for the purpose of authorizing the sale to Peter Froese Loewen of Morris Post Office the SW $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 29-5-1W having been read the first time be now considered as ~~OK~~ being read the second and third time and passed and that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the same. Carried.

By-Law No. 577 was read the first time.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson,

Seconded by Councillor McDonald,

That By-Law No. 577 being a by-law for the purpose of authorizing the sale to David Klassen Eide of the Post Office of Morris the West half of Section 6-6-1W having been read the first time be now considered as having been read the second and third time and passed and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the same. Carried.

Mr. P. H. Penner interviewed the Council in connection with his contract for grading, after a discussion it was agreed to pay the balance on completion of the work.

A number of applications for relief were received and examined and the Council were of the opinion that two thirds of the applications were unnecessary at this time of the year.

The matter of attending the Union of Manitoba Municipalities Convention was discussed and the following resolution passed.

That this Council attend the annual convention of the Union of Manitoba Municipalities and Reeve Churchill be appointed Official delegate. Carried.

Bills and accounts were handed to the finance committee, the finance Committee reported the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor Thiesen,

Seconded by Councillor Gehring,

That the report of the finance Committee be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried.

The meeting then adjourned.
