

Morris, Manitoba,  
May 21st, 1937.

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date, with all the members present. The minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

Mrs. Malo spoke to the Council in connection with a balance owing her in connection with relief orders. She stated that in some cases she had given the parties more than the order called for as she believed it was necessary for them to have the amount, and asked that the Council pay her this amount, after a discussion the following resolution was passed.

Moved by Councillor McDonald,

Seconded by Councillor Stevenson,

That Mrs. Malo be paid in full the excess she issued to relief participants. Carried.

A communication was read from the Provincial Government in connection with the balance of the Kane road construction.

Moved by Councillor Thiesen,

Seconded by Councillor Stevenson,

That this Council is in favor of co-operating with the Provincial Government in constructing the balance of the road from Lowe Farm to Kane, work to be done under the supervision of the Provincial Government on a 50 - 50 basis. Carried.

It was decided that Relief cards in connection with the work would be issued from the Secretary Treasurer's Office.

Mr. Cameron representing the Richardson Machinery Company interviewed the Council in connection with the purchase of a Junior Road Drag. After a discussion the following resolution was passed.

Moved by Councillor Gehring,

Seconded by Councillor Thiesen,

That this Council order a Junior Plover from the Richardson Road Machinery Co, this plover purchased subject to approval. Carried.

Prices for the seasons grading was received from Mr. C.E. Anderson and W. McVicar. Mr Andersons price being the lowest he received the contract for approximately 15 miles of grading by the following resolution.

Moved by Councillor Snarr,

Seconded by Councillor Thiesen,

That the tender of C. E. Anderson for road work be accepted. Carried.

The Reeve explained to the Council that he had met with the Coronation Committee from the Town and had promised a grant of \$50.00 to the Committee.

Moved by Councillor Clubb,

Seconded to Councillor Gehring,

That a grant of \$50.00 be given towards the Coronation celebration. Carried.

Mr. J. Penner's price submitted for the construction of the bridge on Snarrs Coulee was accepted and he was authorized to proceed with the work.

Several communications were read and ordered filed. Bills and accounts were handed to the finance Committee, the finance committee reported the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor Gehring,

Seconded by Councillor Thiesen,

That the report of the finance Committee be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried.

The meeting then adjourned.
