provide for Police protection in Village of Sperling. Carried.

Mr. H. K. Friesen interviewed the Council in connection with an increase of his grant, he stated he was receiving \$10.00 per month but that was not sufficient the Reeve advised him that the matter would have their consideration.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, the Finance Committee reported that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor McDonald. Seconded by Councillor Griffiths,

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried.
