

Morris, Manitoba,
November 21st, 1938.

The Council met on the above date at 9 A.M. with the members present, the meeting was called at 9 A.M. for the purpose of investigating the value of certain Hospital accounts owing to the Municipality. The list was gone over and by law was prepared for cancelling same.

The meeting then adjourned to meet at 1 P.M.

The Council reassembled at 1 P.M. and the minutes of former meeting held October 21st, were read and declared adopted.

At the former meeting a ~~BOARD~~ Court of Revision was held and the following resolution was now passed.

Moved by Councillor Griffiths,
Seconded by Councillor Spalding,

That whereas there has been no appeals against the decision of the Court of Revision held October 21st, 1938, we now declare the Assessment Roll as revised on that date to be the revised assessment Roll for the year 1939. Carried.

Mr. Henry Guilmet interviewed the Council in connection with an extra allowance for the support of his two sisters, he stated the \$20.00 per month was not sufficient, after considering the same the Council decided not to increase the grant.

Mr. Berthelette interviewed the Council in connection with the support of Angeline Berthelette, he stated she had a recent operation and was not able to work for some time and asked that the Council assist in her support.

Moved by Councillor McDonald,
Seconded by Councillor Spalding,

That Angeline Berthelette be allowed \$8.00 per month until May 1939 for board and medicine. Carried.

Messrs. Roberts interviewed the Council in connection with the arrears of taxes on lot 454 and asked that they be cancelled owing to the property being unpatented land. The Council could not see their way clear to do this at the present and instructed the Clerk to secure further information from the Provincial Land Department in connection with same.

An application for old Age Pension from Mrs. Augusta Poersch was presented, after a discussion of same the following resolution was passed.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson,
Seconded by Councillor ~~XXXXXXXX~~, McDonald,

That the application of Augusta Poersch for Old Age Pension be recommended to start January 1st, 1939. Carried.

By Law No. 608 was read a first time.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson,
Seconded by Councillor Griffiths,

That By Law No. 608 being a by law for the purpose of cancelling certain Hospital accounts owing the Municipality, having been read the first time be now considered as having been read the second and third time and passed and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the same. Carried.

Representatives from the Richardson Machinery Company and the Powell Equipment Company spoke to the Council in connection with machinery to keep the roads clear in the winter. The question of attending the Union of Manitoba Municipalities convention on December 6, 7 and 8th, was taken up and the following resolution passed.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson,
Seconded by Councillor Griffiths,

That this Council, as a body, attend the convention of the Manitoba Union of Municipalities and that the Reeve be appointed voting delegate. Carried.

A communication was received from the Department of Health in connection with an application from Mrs. A.D. Wiebe for insulin, the Clerk was instructed to arrange for same.

A number of applications under the farm relief plan were presented to the Council and investigated by same and recommended.

A number of applications were received for relief, a number were recommended.

Bills and accounts were handed the finance Committee, the Finance Committee recommended that same be paid.

Moved by Councillor Griffiths,
Seconded by Councillor McDonald,

That the report of the finance committee be accepted, and that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried.

The meeting then adjourned at 6.30 P.M. to meet again on December 16th, 1938.
