

Morris, Manitoba,
August 16th, 1940.

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date with all the members present. The meeting opened as a Court of Revision in connection with the Electors Roll, the Assessor Mr. C. L. Thring being present. After the list had been examined by the Councillors in their respective Wards and the necessary changes recommended, the following resolution was passed.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson,
Seconded by Councillor McDonald,

That the Court of Revision in regard to the Electors Roll be closed, and that the Electors Roll as revised be the Electors Roll for the year 1940 and that the Clerk be instructed to make 100 copies of the list. Carried.

The Court of Revision was then closed and the meeting was conducted as a regular Council meeting.

By-Law No. 642 was read a first time.

Moved by Councillor Snarr,

Seconded by Councillor Griffiths,

That By-Law No. 642 being a by-law for the purpose of regulating traffic on the Red River Bridge at Morris, having been read a first time be now taken as having been read the second and third time and passed and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the same. Carried.

A letter was read from the Central Concert Committee in regard to a grant for the aid of Evacuee Children. After a discussion the following resolution was passed.

Moved by Councillor Irvine,

Seconded by Councillor Griffiths,

That a grant of \$50.00 be given the Central Concert Committee re refugee Children. Carried.

The Council decided to hold Court of Revision in connection with the Assessment Roll on October 18th, and the following resolution was passed.

Moved by Councillor McDonald,

Seconded by Councillor Stevenson,

That the Court of Revision in regard to the Assessment Roll be held on October 18th at 10 A.M.

The Committee appointed to interview the Provincial Government in connection with bridges reported that assistance had been promised.

The Clerk was requested to have a danger sign erected on the bridge on the Lowe Farm road at SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 5-5-1E

The Council were of the opinion that a by-law should be drawn up restricting weights of loads on earth roads and the Clerk was authorized to have same done.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, the Finance Committee reported that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor McDonald,


Seconded by Councillor Griffiths,

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried.

Prices were read on the printing of Voters Lists from D. W. Friesen & Son, the price being 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ cents per name.

The Council decided to have the list printed by the Sanford Evans Statistical Service.

The meeting then adjourned to meet on September 20th at 1 P.M.
