

Morris, Manitoba,
Sept. 20th, 1940.

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date, present ~~the~~ the Reeve and all the Councillors.

Minutes of former meeting held August 16th were read and declared adopted as read.

Mr. Gus. Mousseau interviewed the Council in connection with a grant towards his support, he stated that he was suffering from Arthritis and was unable to work. The Council were unable to grant his request.

A letter was read from the Workmen's Compensation Board stating that a new policy was necessary in regard to Grading operators, also asking the Council to look after the claim of E. Berthelette, the Council agreed to do this.

A letter was received from Mr. Fred Wait in connection with sale of his plow and Fresno, but the Council were not interested at the price.

A letter was received from McDonald Municipality in connection with the construction of a bridge, the Clerk was instructed to communicate with Engineer Wallace.

The question of securing a house for Mrs. Malo was taken up and the Council were of the opinion it would be advisable to contribute a small amount to her support in Winnipeg as vacant houses were hard to find in the Municipality.

Mr. Cossitt spoke to the Council in connection with the Homemaking Class for girls being organized in Morris this fall, he stated that they desired support from the Municipality and Town. He stated the essential things needed were a stove and a partition for the basement in the Church. The Council decided to purchase the used stove from the Hospital and denote it for use in the basement.

By Law No. 643 was read a first time.

Moved by Councillor Snarr,

Seconded by Councillor Stevenson,

That By-Law No. 643 being a by-law for the purpose of opening a public road over Section Twenty Nine, Township Five, Range One East, having been read the first time be now considered as having been read the second and third time and passed, and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the same. Carried.

The Council adjourned for one half hour to inspect the Community Hospital and when they returned they expressed their approval of same.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, the Finance Committee reported the Treasurere is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor Griffiths,


Seconded by Councillor McDonald,

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried.

The Tax Sale list was discussed and left in abeyance for the present.

The meeting on motion then adjourned to meet as a Court of Revision on October 18th at 10 A.M.
