Morris, Manitoba. June 19th, 1942.

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date with all the members present.

The minutes of the last meeting held May 15th were read and declared adopted as read.

C. L. Kastner interviewed the Council in connection with a private road across the $S^1_{\widehat{\mathbb{Z}}}$ of Sec. 9-5-1E. He asked that the Council establish a public road at this point. The Reeve stated that the Council would investigate.

Messrs. Stewin and Loepp interviewed the Council in connection with roads and drains re Sec. 1-11-2E and Sec. 13-5-2E. It was the intention of the Council to investigate same.

Donat Gratton asked for drainage in connection with Sec. 24-5-2E. It was decided that the Council would investigate the complaint with the others.

A resolution in connection with the Morris River and recommended by the Drainage Commission was submitted to the Council. It was passed by the Council.

It was decided to postpone the next regular meeting until July 24th and the following resolution was passed:

Moved by Councillor McDonald, Seconded by Councillor Stevenson,

That the next regular meeting of the Council be held on July 24th, one week later than the regular date, and that Miss B. A. Jerome be appointed Acting Secretary from July 1st to 24th, during the absence of W. N. Stevenson. Carried.

A discussion in connection with the purchasing of gravel took place and the following resolution passed: Moved by Councillor Stevenson,
Seconded by Councillor McDonald,
That the Secretary be authorized

to order the following gravel:

1000 yards for Lowe Farm 400 yards for Kane 400 yards for Silver Plains 2 carloads for Sperling,

Carried.

A letter was received in connection with the Bouchard children of Aubigny stating that it was requested by the grandfather that an allowance be made by the Child Welfare. The matter was left to the Committee.

A letter was received from the Municipality of Montcalm in connection with C. C. Peck's complaint re trespassing on his property. The Clerk was ordered to issue a cheque for \$10.00 in favor of C. C. Peck.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, the Finance Committee reported that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor Davidson,

That the report of the Finance

That the report of the several committee be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk issue cheques for the several accounts. Carried.

The meeting then adjourned to meet in regular session on July 24th, 1942.
