

Morris, Manitoba.
August 21st, 1942.

The Council met as a Court of Revision on the above date to revise the Elector's Roll. All the members were present, also the Assessor, C. L. Thring.

The different changes were recommended by the Councillors in their respective wards and the following resolution was passed:

Moved by Councillor Griffiths,

Seconded by Councillor Spalding,

That the Court of Revision in regard to the Elector's Roll be closed and that the Elector's Roll as revised be the Elector's Roll for 1942 and that the Clerk be instructed to have 100 copies printed. Carried.

The Court of Revision was then closed and the Council met in regular session. The minutes of the former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

A communication ^{WAS READ} from the Huron and Erie Mortgage Company in connection with drainage re N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2-5-2W. The Clerk was instructed to advise the Company that there was a good ditch on the north side and one on the south side of the quarter at the present time.

Councillor McDonald advised the Council of the condition of the ditch east of Sec. 12 and 13-6-2E. He stated that the Municipality of Desalaberry was willing to co-operate if advised. The Clerk was instructed to write in regard to same.

The Clerk was also instructed to write to the Department in connection with the profile for the drain east of the river.

Mr. Slater interviewed the Council in connection with the road difficulty at David Walter's farm. He stated that he thought it could be settled in an amicable manner. He was requested to make an effort to do so.

A request was received from Klyne Cox of Union Point for permission to move a house on that portion of road allowance east of the Highway and north of Lot 527 which is not in use. The permission was granted.

A representative from ^{Canada Mortgage Corp.} ~~Western Steel Products Company~~ interviewed the Council in connection with the sale of culverts and the Council placed orders for several.

The Reeve explained that Mr. Neufeld of Pleasant Valley was removed to Steinbach and his maintenance would amount to 50 cents per day.


Bills and accounts were presented to the Finance Committee, the Finance Committee reported that the Treasurer be authorized to pay the accounts as per list.
