That this Municipality assume the responsibility of maintaining the planks between the rails at Sewell crossing,

A discussion took place regarding the proposed ditches in Ward Four. As the work called-for could not be done with the Elevator Grader it was decided that a Drag line would be necessary.

The Secretary was instructed to write to the Department of Public Works re inspection of Lowe Farm Road.

> By-Law No. 663 was read the first time. Moved by Councillor Spalding, Seconded by Councillor Stevenson,

That By-Law No. 663 being a By-Law for the purpose of providing for the nomination and election of three Councillors for the years 1943-1944 having been read the first time be now considered as having been read the second and third time and passed, and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal same. Carried.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, the Finance Committee reported that the Clerk be authorized to pay the accounts as per list. Moved by Councillor Stevenson,

Moved by Councillor Davidson,

That the report of the Finance

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried.

The meeting then adjourned to meet in regular session on Friday November 20th.
