Morris, Manitoba. February 19, 1943.

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date with all the members present except Councillor Griffiths.

The minutes of the former meeting were read and declared adopted

A communication was read from the Municipal Commissioner re post-war development and reconstructtion giving an outline of different lines of work that could be established.

The Council examined same and the Secretary was instructed to write to the Department with particulars in connection with same.

Applications were received for the positions of Ferrymen at Union Point and Silver Plains from A. Berthelette, L. Bouchard and U. St. Jacques. The following resolution was passed: Moved by Councillor Stevenson, Seconded by Councillor McDonald,

That the application of L. Bouchard be accepted to run Union Point Ferry at the price set by the Council, and that the application of U. St. Jacques be accepted to run Silver Plains Ferry providing he accepts the price set by the Municipality. Carried.

> The following resolution was passed in connection with Assessment: Moved by Councillor Spalding,
>
> That the Assessment Roll for Moved by Councillor Davidson,

the year 1943be adopted as the Assessment Roll for the year 1944, and that the Assessor be instructed to make the necessary changes in same. Carried.

> By-Law No. 670 was read the first time. Moved by Councillor Spalding, Seconded by Councillor Anderson,

That By-Law No. 670 being a By-Law of the Municipality for the purpose of setting the mates for the year 1943 and authorizing the collection of same, having been read the first time be now considered as having been read the second and third time and passed and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal same. Carried.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, the Finance Committee reported that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor McDonald, Seconded by Councillor Stevenson,

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried.

The meeting then adjorned to meet on Friday March 19th.
