

Morris, Manitoba.
March 19th, 1943.

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date with all the members present except Councillor Griffiths.

The minutes of the former meeting held February 19th were read and declared adopted as read.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson,
Seconded by Councillor McDonald,

That Councillor Anderson be appointed to the Morris Community Hospital Board as from February 19th 1943. Carried.

A donation to the Red Cross Society was discussed and the following motion was passed:

Moved by Councillor Spalding,
Seconded by Councillor Davidson,

That this Council make a grant of Three Hundred Dollars to the Red Cross Society. Carried.

A discussion took place in regard to the setting of rates of wages to be paid by the Municipality for the season 1943.

Moved by Councillor McDonald,
Seconded by Councillor Davidson,

That the schedule of rates for the Rural Municipality of Morris for the season 1943 be as follows:

Foreman	.45 per hour & .10 per hr. for use of own tools
Laborer	.40 " "
Man & team	.70 " "
Man & two teams	1.00 " "
One-way drag	.70 per mile, one round
Two-way drag	1.00 " " " "
Three-way drag	1.10 " " " "
Tractor & man	1.50 per Hour
Man on planer	.40 " "
Tractor & Grader men	.60 " "
Rubber-tired Tractor on ten-foot three-blade Drag	.90 per mile

Carried.

Moved by Councillor Spalding,
Seconded by Councillor Anderson,

That owing to the publicity and circumstances of the case of Mrs. Elizabeth Schroeder this Council urge the Child Welfare Division to continue maintenance and protection of this family and that the Secretary Treasurer be instructed to forward a copy of this resolution to the Child Welfare Division. Carried.

The question of allowing the Secretary Treasurer a leave of absence was discussed and the following resolution was passed:

Moved by Councillor Spalding,
Seconded by Councillor Anderson,

That the Secretary Treasurer be given leave of absence for two months commencing July 1st and that he be paid one month's salary during this period. Carried.


