

Morris, Manitoba.  
September 15, 1944.

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date with all members present.

The minutes of the former meeting held August 18th were read and declared adopted as read.

A communication was read from C. J. Campbell, Secretary of the Local Ration Board, in connection with grant to the Board, discontinued as from April 30th. Mayor Francis of Morris was asked to attend the Council meeting and discuss with the members of the Rural Council the Town's attitude in connection with said grant.

Mr. Alphonse Hebert presented a letter to the Reeve, from Mr. J. T. Beaubien asking for \$600.00 damages from the Municipality, for damages to his crop from flooding. The Clerk was instructed to advise Mr. Beaubien of the particulars.

A petition was presented from A. J. Klassen and several others asking for the deepening of the Kronsgard Drain. The Reeve explained that it was the intention of the Drainage Maintenance Board to have the work done sometime in the future.

The Reeve discussed the matter of Drainage very thoroughly with the Council and the Council was of the opinion that they would be well advised to purchase a Drag Line so that new work could be done and old work maintained.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson,

Seconded by Councillor Anderson,

That the Secretary-Treasurer be instructed to secure prices on  $\frac{1}{2}$  to 1 yard Drag lines from the different Machine Companies. Carried.

Mr. Hamilton of the Canada Ingot Iron Company interviewed the Council in connection with a new application for the "99" Maintainer. The Reeve explained that the Council was more interested in a Drag-Line at present, and decided that the order for the Maintainer would be left in abeyance for the present. A conditional order for culverts for the 1945 season was placed with Mr. Hamilton.

A discussion took place in connection with the immunization of School children and the remuneration set at not more than \$1.50 per child. It was agreed to have the children attending the Melba School from Morris Municipality immunized and inoculated when the other children of the school are being done.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, the Finance Committee reported that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.


Moved by Councillor Anderson,
