

Morris, Manitoba.
April 18th, 1946.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris was held on the above date with all members present.

The minutes of the meeting held March 15th were read and declared adopted as read.

A delegation waited in the Council with respect to roads and drains in their vicinity, and were advised that when possible, the matter would be attended to.

Mr. Ed Lohr also waited on Council re: a bridge and drain at his land, and was also advised that this would be looked after.

Mr. O'Brian waited on Council with regard to Re-establishment credit Re: Allan Kastner and explained necessary procedure re: same.

Moved by Councillor Anderson.

Seconded by Councillor Thiessen.

That we acquiesce with the suggestion of Mr. O'Brian regarding Re-establishment credit contract with G.A. Kastner, as from April 1st, 1946 to the end of the year, and the Reeve is hereby authorized to sign same on behalf of the Municipality. Carried.

A letter from the Shriners Hospital for Crippled Children, asking for a grant, was read, and the following motion was passed.

That the Rural Municipality of Morris give a grant of \$50.00 to the Shriners Hospital fund. Carried.

That P.A. Falk be appointed operator on the Maintainer for the year 1946, as per his application. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson.

Seconded by Councillor McDonald.

That the applications for Old Age pensions of Karl & Mrs. Mazolleck, be recommended to the Old Age Pensions Board for Acceptance. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson.

Seconded by Councillor Davidson.

That the application of H.I. Dyck for admittance to the St. Boniface home for aged and infirm be recommended. Carried.

By-Law No. 701 was read the first time.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson.

Seconded by Councillor Davidson.

That By-Law No. 701, being a By-Law for the purpose of borrowing up to \$40,000.00, from the Bank of Montreal, Morris, Man., having been read the first time, be now considered as having been read the second and Third time and passed, and the Reeve and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and Seal same. Carried.

By-Law No. 702 was read the First time.

Moved by Councillor Ribordy.

Seconded by Councillor Thiessen.

That By-Law No. 702, being a By-Law for the purpose of confirming the purchase of a house and lot from the Manitoba Pool Elevators having been read the First time, be now considered as having been Read the Second and Third time and passed. And the Reeve and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and Seal same. Carried.



Bills and Accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, who reported that the Treasurer is authorized to pay same as per list. Carried.
