Mr.Lorne Ritz waited on the Council with regard to purchaseing a portion of Sec. 1-4-1W. and the following motion passed.

Moved by Councillor Davidson. Seconded by Councillor Stevenson.

That we sell the Triangular .96 Acres less the most Westerly 33 feet in Sec.1-Twp.4-Range lW. to Lorne Ritz for the sum of \$ 58.00 and the Municipality to assume all costs. Carried.

Mr.P.E.Friesen waited on the Council with regard to the nuisance caused by refuse from the Cheese Factory and was advised that Councillor Anderson would look into the matter.

Mr. Keating waited on the Council with regard to road Machinery.

Mr. Herman and Son waited on the Council with regard to an approach to some of their land, and was advised that Reeve Heppner would attend to same. A letter from the Dept.of Health and Public Welfare, in which we were asked to appoint members to the Morris Hospital Board, was read, and the following motion passed.

That Councillors Stevenson and Davidson

That Councillors Stevenson and Davidson and Messrs.P.U.Brandt and J.Covernton be appointed Members of the Morris Hospital Board. Carried.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, who reported that the Treasurer be authorized to pay seme as per list.

Moved by Councillor Anderson.

Seconded by Councillor Ribordy.

That the Finance report be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk be hereby authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried.

The Meeting was then adjourned to meet again August 16th, next.
