

Morris, Manitoba.
August 16th, 1946.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its' regular Meeting on the above date in the Court House Building. Reeve Heppner, and Councillors Anderson, Thiessen and Ribordy being present, the Secretary read the Minutes of the last Meeting, which were adopted as being correct.

At the Hour of 2.00 O'Clock P.M. the Reeve asked the Council to sit as a Court of Revision and the Assessor, Mr. C.L. Thring was present for that purpose. and the following Motions were passed.

Moved by Councillor Ribordy.

Seconded by Councillor Thiessen.

That the changes in the list of Electors made by the Assessor be accepted and the list made by him accordingly. CARRIED.

Moved by Councillor Thiessen.

Seconded by Councillor Anderson.

That the Court of Revision do now close as there were no appeals lodged and that the electors' toll as revised be the electors' toll for the year 1946 and the clerk be hereby instructed to have 100 copies printed. CARRIED.

By-Law No. 706 was read a First time.

Moved by Councillor Anderson.

Seconded by Councillor Thiessen.

That By-Law No. 706 being a By-Law for the purpose of approving the Plan of an additional survey to the Village of Lowe-Farm, having been read the First time be now considered as having been read the Second and Third times and Passed and the Reeve and Clerk be hereby authorized to sign and Seal same. CARRIED.

Dr. Moffat of the Provincial Sanitorium Board waited on the Council with regard to organizing a Mass Chest XRAY in the Municipality and Town of Morris. Members from various organizations were present to hear Dr. Moffat outline the necessary procedure for the work, the dates for the survey were set for the latter part of September and the First part of October 1946. Volunteers showed their willingness to help with the worthy undertaking.

Reeve Heppner appointed the Councillors present, to be the Finance Committee for the Meeting.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, who reported that the Treasurer be authorized to pay same as per list.

Moved by Councillor Ribordy.

Seconded by Councillor Thiessen.

That the Finance report be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. CARRIED.

The Meeting then adjourned until September 20th, next.
