

Morris, Manitoba.
November 15th, 1946.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its' regular meeting on the above date in the Court House Chambers. All Members being present, the Secretary read the Minutes of the last Meeting, which were adopted as being correct. By-Law # 713 was read a first time.

Thiessen - Ribordy:

That By-Law # 713, being a By-Law for the purpose of transferring N.W. 25-5-2W. to Jacob Braun of Lowe Farm, having been read the First time, be now considered as having been read the second and Third times and passed, and the Reeve and Clerk be hereby authorized to sign and seal same. CARRIED.

By-Law # 714 was read a First time.

McDonald - Thiessen :

That By-Law # 714, being a By-Law of the Municipality Re. a survey of an addition to the Village of Lowe Farm, having been read the First time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed, and the Reeve and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and seal same. CARRIED.

Davidson - Stevenson :

That this Council attend the Convention of the Union of Manitoba Municipalities, and that Reeve Heppner be appointed the official voting delegate, and that the actual expenses be paid by the Municipality. CARRIED.

Ribordy - Davidson :

That we hereby agree to assign Tax Sale Certificate # 10 dated the 7th day of December 1942 re. part of Sec. 29-6-2 W.L., to Mr. C.B. McNulty of Sperling, Man., providing he pays the necessary amount for such assignment CARRIED.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance committee, who reported that the Treasurer be authorized to pay same as per list .

Ribordy - Anderson :

That the Finance report be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. CARRIED.

The meeting then adjourned until Friday Dec. 20th, next.

The annual Nomination meeting was held in the Court House at Morris on Nov. 12th. At the hour of Two O'Clock P.M. the Clerk read the nominations, being R. Davidson acclaimed Councillor for Ward One and H. Anderson acclaimed Councillor for Ward Two for the years 1947 and 1948. There was no Nomination for Ward Four.

Mr. Moody, by motion of Mr. Taylor and Mr. Reid was chairman for the meeting.

The Reeve and each Councillor was called on in turn to give an account of the Municipalities work and the work in each respective ward. Reeve Heppner well outlined the receipts and disbursements of the Municipality for the year 1946 as at Oct. 31st and each Councillor as called on gave a satisfactory account of his Ward expenditures and programme.

Some discussion took place re. the road equipment and operators, and various opinions were voiced in this respect.

It was suggested that the Minutes of the Council Meetings should be published in the paper and after some discussion took place and the Council advised that each Member had a copy which could be seen at all reasonable times, it was decided that the system now used would be satisfactory to continue with.

The meeting adjourned about 4.00 P.M. and no doubt those present gained a clearer view of the work and workings of the Council.
